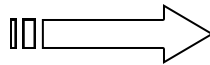

For Exiting 5th Graders

This class is designed to help students exiting 5th grade to read and understand novels. The class will be taught using the Literature circle method allowing students to master vocabulary, comprehension, summarizing, and author's viewpoint. Students will incorporate reading and writing through their daily practice. Titles may include: *James and the Giant Peach*, *Charlie and the Chocolate Factory*, and/or *Peter Pan*. Informational texts, articles, and multi-media will be included to aid in comprehension of the chosen novel.

This class reflects the Birmingham Public School District's math curriculum and will be taught by BPS staff. This comprehensive class is structured for BPS students who want to sharpen their math skills. Emphasis will be placed on utilizing skills and applying math concepts to problems and projects. This course will help prepare students for the future by focusing on the upcoming school year's concepts as well. This is a math based enrichment course that aims to challenge students who are already excelling in mathematics courses during the regular school year.
