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HEARTSAVER/FIRST AID/CPR/AED Blended Learning Course (Adults)

This course is designed to teach students the cognitive information necessary for First Aid, CPR (adult, child, infant) and AED training. The blended course allows participants to learn at their own pace from home. Upon completion of the online portion, students must complete a hands-on in-person skills session. This course provides students with the convenience of completing the course at their own pace. Includes interactive exercises and videos to engage students, along with audio and transcript for students who may have a hearing or visual disability. Once you have registered for the course at www.communityed.net, an email with the link to the online course will be sent. After completion of the online course, a certificate of completion will be issued. After the online portion is complete, the hands-on/in-person skills session must occur within 60 days. The instructor will contact you to schedule the skills session; after completion, your certification card will be issued. Certification cards are now digital e-cards which may be saved to your computer or printed if necessary. The skills session will take place between March 1 and July 1, Tuesdays or Thursdays, 5:30 - 6:30 p.m. or by appointment, at Hollmann CPR & First Aid Training, North Green Field, 29551 Greenfield, Suite 103, Southfield, MI 48076. SPECIAL RULES FOR SPRING 2021

SPECTATORS. Spectators are restricted to the stands. Only 2 coaches per team may enter the fenced turf area. There is no limit to the number of spectators. Only individuals from the same household can sit together and masks must be worn at all times.

MASKS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES. All spectators/players/coaches/refs/staff must wear masks at all times while on the premises including during practices and games. Noncompliance could lead to the removal of the participant and cancellation of games. This is for the safety of your child, as well as others. If a child is unable to wear a mask, we are sorry, but for safety reasons, no participation can be allowed.

SAFETY. If any player, coach or referee on your child's team or opposing team tests positive for Covid, your child will be unable to participate in the following week's practice/game. For example, Team A plays Team B in week 1. A player on team A has a positive Covid result during the week following week 1's game. All coaches and players on team A, plus all coaches and players on Team B cannot play in week 2. As long as there are no symptoms, or further positive Covid tests, players and coaches will return for week 3. Participants will not be refunded for any missed games. There will be NO make-up games.
