- Only volunteer for a week if you can come all 5 days of that week. Week 2 (June 30-July 4) there are no camps.
- Be prepared to volunteer inside and outside.
- <u>NO</u> technology/cell phone use while volunteering.
- Volunteers should have a positive attitude and provide a fun and safe environment for campers.
- You can sign up to volunteer with a friend, but you may not be "together" while volunteering.
